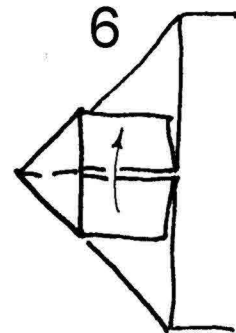
Valley noting the location points
